Contract for DJ Services

AGREEMENT made this ____ day of _____, 20__, by and between _____, hereinafter referred to as the Purchaser, and Central Missouri Sound, hereinafter referred to as the DJ.

WITNESSETH NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and the agreements herein contained and intending to be legally bound hereby, the Parties do agree as follows:

1. The Purchaser hereby engages the DJ to provide a DJ Service. The service to be performed at Event Location:

2. Central Missouri Sound hereby agrees to provide a DJ Service for the Purchaser at the above mentioned location.

3. The said DJ Service shall consist primarily of providing musical entertainment by means of a recorded music format.

4. Central Missouri Sound hereby agrees to render his professional services and is at all times to have complete control of his program.

5. The Parties hereby agree that the DJ Service shall be provided and accepted on the following date(s) and time(s) of the engagement:

6. The Purchaser in consideration of the DJ Service to be rendered by the DJ, and the mutual promises contained herein, hereby agrees to pay to the DJ the following consideration:

A non-refundable reservation fee of \$50.00, is required to secure the services of Central Missouri Sound for the engagement. This amount shall be applied toward the Performance Fee.

Services requested that exceed the time frame will be charged at the rate of \$_____ per hour, payable the day of the engagement. It may not always be possible to provide additional performance time. However, when feasible, requests for extended playing time will be accommodated if payment is offered at the time of the request.

Additional Terms and Conditions

The agreement of the DJ to perform is subject to proven detention by accidents, riots, strikes, epidemics, acts of God, or any other legitimate conditions beyond their control. If such circumstances arise, all reasonable efforts will be made by Central Missouri Sound to find replacement entertainment at the agreed upon fees. Should Central Missouri Sound be unable to procure a replacement, Purchaser shall receive a full refund. Purchaser agrees that in all circumstances, Central Missouri Sound's liability shall be exclusively limited to an amount equal to the performance fee and that Central Missouri Sound shall not be liable for indirect or consequential damages arising from any breach of contract.

No performance on the engagement shall be recorded, reproduced, or transmitted from the place of performance, in any manner, or any means whatsoever, in the absence of a specific written agreement with Central Missouri Sound relating to and permitting such recording, reproduction, or transmission. Pictures and videotape of the event are permitted for the private use of the contracting party only.

The purchaser and DJ agree that this contract is not subject to cancellation unless both parties have agreed to such cancellation in writing within 60 days of the event. In the event the Purchaser breaches the contract, he or she shall pay the DJ the amount set forth above as the non-refundable reservation fee. All deposits are nonrefundable unless the DJ cancels the engagement.

It is hereby further agreed; that the Purchaser shall be held liable for any injury or damages to the DJ, or property of the DJ, while on the premises of said engagement, if damage is caused by Purchaser or guest, members of his organization, engagement invitees, employees, or any other party in attendance, whether invited or not.

It is understood that if this is a "Rain or Shine" event, Central Missouri Sound's compensation is in no way affected by inclement weather. For outdoor performances, Purchaser shall provide overhead shelter for setup area. The DJ reserves the right, in good faith, to stop or cancel the performance should the weather pose a potential danger to him, the equipment, or audience. Every effort will be made to continue the performance. However, safety is paramount in all decisions. The DJ's compensation will not be affected by such cancellation.

In the event of circumstances deemed to present a threat or implied threat of injury or harm to Central Missouri Sound staff or any equipment in Central Missouri Sound possession, Central Missouri Sound reserves the right to cease performance. If the Purchaser is able to resolve the threatening situation in a reasonable amount of time (maximum of 15 minutes), Central Missouri Sound shall resume performance in accordance with the original terms of this agreement. Purchaser shall be responsible for payment in full, regardless of whether the situation is resolved or whether Central Missouri Sound resumes performance. In order to prevent equipment damage or liability arising from accidental injury to any individual attending this performance, Central Missouri Sound reserves the right to deny any guest access to the sound system, music recordings, or other equipment.

Purchaser shall provide Central Missouri Sound with safe and appropriate working conditions. This includes a 20-foot by 6-foot area for setup, space for setting up speakers and lighting stands. Central Missouri Sound requires a minimum of one 15-20-amp circuit outlet from a reliable power source within 50 feet (along the wall) of the set-up area. This circuit must be free of all other connected loads. Any delay in the performance or damage to DJ's equipment due to improper power is the responsibility of

the purchaser. Two circuits are preferred, where possible. Additional outlets on SEPARATE circuits for lighting (if contracted for) are preferred.

The Purchaser shall at all times have complete control, direction and supervision of the performance of Central Missouri Sound at this engagement and Purchaser expressly reserves the right to control the manner, means and details of the performance of the services of Central Missouri Sound. A written Wedding or event planner or music request list must be received from the Purchaser and forwarded to Central Missouri Sound at least 30 days prior to the date of the engagement for it to be included in Central Missouri Sound programming guidelines. With or without the aid of a wedding or event planner or music request list, Central Missouri Sound shall attempt to play Purchaser's and Purchaser's guests' music requests but shall not be held responsible if certain selections are unavailable. Central Missouri Sound will make an extra effort to have music requests available if they are received IN WRITING at least 30 days prior to the engagement.

In the event of non-payment, Central Missouri Sound retains the right to attempt collection through the courts. Purchaser will be held responsible for all court fees, legal fees, and collection costs incurred by Central Missouri Sound. Purchaser shall be charged \$25 for each bounced check plus a \$7.50 service charge for each collection notice.

This agreement guarantees that Central Missouri Sound will be ready to perform at the start time of the engagement. No guarantee is made as to Central Missouri Sound time of arrival; however, Central Missouri Sound requests that they be permitted 60 minutes before the engagement and 45 minutes after the engagement for setup and takedown. Central Missouri Sound also requests ramp or elevator access between the parking/service entrance and the setup area if necessary. If Purchaser or venue requires Central Missouri Sound to complete setup more than one hour before the start time, or to postpone takedown more than hour after the end time indicated, the additional time will be charged a flat rate of \$50.00.

Engagements within a 25 mile radius of Taos, Missouri, will not be assessed a travel charge. Services requiring travel outside of this area will be charged at the Federal Mileage Allowance (as of the date of the event) in excess of 25 miles. Engagements in excess of 150 miles will require accommodations be made for an overnight stay in a local hotel/motel for Central Missouri Sound to be provided by Purchaser.

Special Provisions & Additional Services Requested

By executing this contract as Purchaser, the person executing said contract, either individually, or as an agent or representative, represents and warrants that he or she is eighteen (18) years of age, and further, if executing said contract as agent or representative, that he or she has the authority to enter into this agreement and should he or she not have such authority, he or she personally accepts and assumes full responsibility and liability under the terms of this contract.

All attached riders are an integral part of this contract. This contract will supersede any other contract. If any part of this contract is illegal or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this contract will remain valid and enforceable to both parties. This contract contains the entire agreement between the parties and no statement, promises, or inducements made by any party hereto, or agent or representative or either party hereto, which are not contained in this written contract, shall be valid or binding. contract shall not be enlarged, modified, or altered except in writing by both parties and endorsed hereon.

The laws of the State of Missouri shall govern this agreement. In the event of suit involving or relating to this agreement, Purchaser agrees that venue will be in Cole County, Missouri. Purchaser agrees to defend, indemnify, assume liability for and hold Central Missouri Sound harmless from any claims, damages, losses and expenses by or to any person, regardless of the basis, which pertains directly or indirectly to Central Missouri Sound performance. In the event that a civil action arises in an effort to enforce any provision of this agreement, the losing party shall pay the attorney's fee and court costs of the prevailing party. Purchaser may not transfer this contract to another party without the prior written consent of Central Missouri Sound. This agreement is not binding until signed by both Purchaser and Central Missouri Sound has received it. Any changes must be written and signed by both the Purchaser and Central Missouri Sound. Oral agreements are non-binding. If any clause in this agreement is found to be illegal, the rest of the agreement shall remain in force.

Central Missouri Sound may elect not to exercise their rights as specified in this agreement. By doing so, Central Missouri Sound does not waive their right to exercise those options at a future date.

THE PARTIES hereto promise to abide by the terms of this agreement and intend to be legally bound thereby.
